

Ordinance  
No. 11

An Ordinance to prohibit Hogs, Mules, Horses, Mares, Bulls, Cows, Oxen and Calves from running at large within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty on the owner for violation of same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no hogs, mules, horses, mares, bulls, cows, oxen or calves shall be allowed to run at large within the corporate limits of Leonardtown; provided that the owner or keeper, of any hogs, mules, horses, mares, bulls, cows, oxen or calves found running at large within the corporate limits of Leonardtown, in violation of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 and costs, nor more than \$10.00 and costs, and in default of fine, shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a period not exceeding five (5) days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

Be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid that this ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
