

ORDINANCE NO. 39

An Ordinance to provide for discounts for payment made prior to October 1 of each year in which levied of ordinary municipal taxes of Leonardtown.

Section 1: WHEREAS, by Section 48 (b) of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957), as amended, the Commissioners of Leonardtown were authorized and empowered as to its own taxes to allow discounts for payments made prior to October 1 of each year in which levied.

Section 2: Therefore, be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, this 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1969, that discounts for payments made prior to October 1 of each year in which levied of ordinary municipal taxes of Leonardtown shall be allowed as follows:

(a) A discount of one and one-half per centum ( $1\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) for such payments made during the month of July.

(b) A discount of One per centum (1%) for such payments made during the month of August.

(c) A discount of One-half of One per centum ( $\frac{1}{2}\%$ ) for such payments made during the month of September.

Section 3: And be it further enacted and ordained that this Ordinance shall take effect as of the date of its passage and enactment.
