

Ordinance
No 5.

An Ordinance to prohibit the deposit of ashes, rubbish or any waste materials, on or upon any of the public sidewalks, alleyways, streets or waterways within the Corporate Limits of Leonardtown, and to provide a penalty for violations of the same.

Section 1.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Commissioners of Leonardtown, that no ashes, rubbish or other waste materials of any kind, shall be deposited on or upon any of the Public sidewalks, alleyways, streets, roadways or waterways, within the Corporate Limits of Leonardtown at any time; provided that any firm, corporation or individual violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not less than \$1.00 and costs, nor more than \$10.00 and costs, and when said fine and costs are not paid, the party convicted and fined shall be committed to the St. Mary's County jail for a term not exceeding Ten days, or until discharged in due course of law.

Section 2.

And be it further enacted and ordained by the authority aforesaid, that this Ordinance shall take effect from the date of its passage.
