### AN ORDINANCE concerning

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#### WATER AND SEWER IMPACT FEES

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FOR the purpose of increasing the amounts of water and sewer impact fees payable upon the issuance of occupancy permits in the Town of Leonardtown; providing certain exceptions from the payment of such increased water and sewer impact fees for a certain period of time under certain conditions; and all matters generally relating to the imposition and collection of water and sewer impact fees in the Town of Leonardtown.

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**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT:** Chapter 62 of the Code of the Town of Leonardtown provides for the imposition of certain impact fees in connection with the issuance of building permits in the Town of Leonardtown, such impact fees payable upon the issuance of occupancy permits. The current Development Impact Fee Schedule for the imposition and collection of water and sewer impact fees was enacted by the Town Council in 1990 pursuant to Ordinance No. 61. Section 62-4 of the Leonardtown Town Code authorizes the Town Council to review and revise the Development Impact Fee Schedule periodically. The Town Council, with the assistance of the Town Treasurer and Town Administrator, has reviewed existing water and sewer impact fees and has determined that increases in such fees are warranted for new development. Now, therefore,

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SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF **LEONARDTOWN** that the Town's Development Impact Fee Schedule is amended by increasing the amount of the Water Impact Fee for all land use types from \$960 per EDU (Equivalent Dwelling Unit) to \$1,800 per EDU, and by increasing the amount of the Sewer Impact Fee for all land use types from \$810 per EDU to \$2,850 per EDU. The Town Treasurer shall promulgate and maintain a revised Development Impact Fee Schedule that includes the changes to the Water and Sewer Impact Fees adopted by this Ordinance.

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SECTION II: AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that, notwithstanding the provisions of Section I of this Ordinance, water and sewer impact fees at the rates in effect prior to the enactment of this Ordinance shall continue to apply to any lot or

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land use that received building permits prior to the effective date of this Ordinance and for all projects that have received final subdivision approval prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, provided that in any of such cases both water and sewer impact fees are paid on or before June 30, 2006. Water and sewer impact fees at the rates established in Section I of this Ordinance shall apply to any such lot or land use that has not paid both water and sewer impact fees prior to July 1, 2006.

SECTION III: AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That if any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions or any other application of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end, all the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

**SECTION IV: AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** that this Ordinance shall become effective twenty (20) days following approval by the Mayor or passage by the affirmative vote of four-fifths of the whole Council after veto by the Mayor.
